Housing

About the Program

- Four week trip to Spain during the summer, from June 24 to July 27, 2012.
- Study at Universidad de Deusto in Bilbao.
- Open to UMW students in all majors, and non-UMW students.

Program Fees

- Spanish Studies - \$4,875
- Interdisciplinary Studies - \$5,275

Participation Requirements

- Spanish language proficiency recommended but not required.
- 12 or more UMW credits.
- Minimum 2.5 GPA.

General Education Requirements

Students can complete the following UMW general education requirements:

- Foreign Language.
