

How does this work?

Alrighty, this process should be relatively painless. We hope.

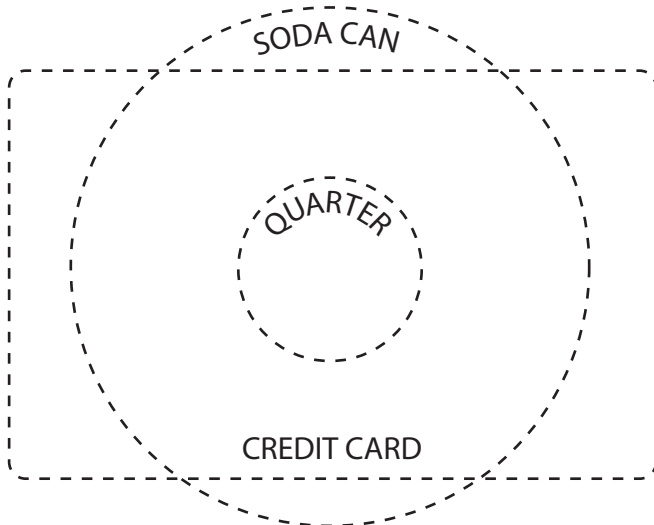
1. Find your child. (We recommend bribing with ice cream. It worked for our test subjects.)

3. Then, measure! YAY!
4. If they're not kicking and screaming, measure the left foot as well.
5. If the two feet are different sizes, choose the larger size when buying shoes.
