The pH Scale

A pH scale of 7 is neutral. 0 is the most acidic pH rating. 14 is the most basic (alkaline/caustic) pH rating. The pH scale is a logarithmic scale. Each unit of change equals a "Power of Ten". A pH of 3 is actually 10 times more acidic than a pH of 4. Conversely, a pH of 13 is actually 10 times more alkaline than a pH of 12. Therefore, a pH of 13 is 10,000 times more alkaline/caustic than a pH of 9!
